- 2. Official transcripts of grades
- 3. A description of your coursework (usually the university prints a pamphlet describing what courses are required for a degree in music therapy)
- 4. Three letters of reference
- 5. A statement from the director of your Music Therapy Department verifying your anticipated completion of coursework and approving your application for internship here (This can be in one of the three letters of reference).

Please also include a cover letter introducing yourself and describing your interest in this clinical population.

We ask that you complete the application process at your earliest convenience.

Attached you will find a description of our internship program.
